At pages 58–62 there is a list of words and passages which had been deleted in the first and second editions of the *Epistolae ad Gallos* (TMD 1213 and 1214), subsequently republished in the *Epistolae quotquot reperiri potuerunt*, but can be found in the Dupuys' copy of the *Epistolae ad Gallos*, which was not consulted by the editors of the *Briefwisseling* either. At pp. 67–68 there is an appendix which surveys the gaps in *Ep. Gal. Rés. Z 2243* which are not filled in in the Dupuy copy either, and an appendix listing the printing errors which in *Ep. Gal. Rés. Z 2243* have been corrected.
